Introduction

School library media specialists rely on the published contributions of colleagues for the latest issues, trends, and concerns in the school media field. Periodical literature continues to be an immediate platform for the sharing of ideas and opinions. The articles are indexed under six subject areas: 1) information service; 2) instructional consulting; 3) literature; 4) management; 5) notable authors, illustrators, and librarians; and 6) teaching. The articles from 11 journals were used to compile the index: *Book Report, Emergency Librarian, Journal of Youth Services in Libraries (JOYS), Library Talk, Media & Methods, School Library Journal (SLJ), School Library Media Activities Monthly, School Library Media Quarterly, Voice of Youth Advocates (VOYA), School Librarian's Workshop, and Wilson Library Bulletin*.

Management is emphasized in the 1994 literature with a particular focus on automation and telecommunications. Articles on censorship, cultural diversity, and professional development appear in the journals. Recognizing the concerns over shrinking budgets, several articles address the steps of applying for grants. As in the 1993 index of 1993 articles, there is a continued interest in instructional consulting, specifically in science and social studies.
