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School media specialists need speedy access to information in the field, whether a bibliography to share with a teacher, an idea for teaching an information skill, or an interesting article about some management problem. The annual resources continue to provide a wealth of information. This index provides the newest information in the school media field published in current periodicals in the areas of information science, instructional consulting, management, and teaching. Three new areas have been added to the subject list this year: literary consulting; notable authors, illustrators, and librarians; and school reform. Twelve journals were used in preparation of the index: *Book Report*, *Book Talk*, *Emergency Librarian*, *Journal of Youth Services (JOYS)*, *Library Talk*, *Media & Methods*, *School Librarians's Workshop*, *School Library Journal (SLJ)*, *School Library Media Activities Monthly*, *School Library Media Quarterly*, *Voice of Youth Advocates (VOYA)*, and *Wilson Library Bulletin*.

Articles about management are emphasized; however, teaching and instructional consulting continue to increase in importance. This year's research revealed continued interest in whole language programs, multiculturalism, audiovisual services, and computer applications in both management and teaching. A renewed interest was shown in cooperation with outside agencies, facilities, evaluation, interdisciplinary studies, and using volunteers. Library and information skills instruction and production of audiovisual materials continue as subjects of interest in the field.
