One of the most compelling challenges for the school library media specialist is to keep abreast of the newest trends in the school media field and to be proactive leaders in schools. The resources allow the sharing of ideas for improving services and for making contributions to the field. The annual periodical sources continue to provide an abundance of information. The most current information provided in this index are in seven subject areas: 1) information service, 2) instructional consulting, 3) literature, 4) management 5) notable authors, illustrators, and librarians, 6) school reform, and (7) teaching. Eleven journals were used in preparation of the index: *Book Report*, *Emergency Librarian*, *Journal of Youth Services in Libraries (JOYS)*, *Library Talk*, *Media & Methods*, *School Librarians' Workshop*, *School Library Journal (SLJ)*, *School Library Media Activities Monthly*, *School Library Media Quarterly*, *Voice of Youth Advocates (VOYA)*, and *Wilson Library Bulletin*.

As last year, management continues to be emphasized in the literature, with teaching and instructional consulting growing in importance. Research in literature is noticeably increasing. More articles on school reform are appearing in journals, as well as those related to telecommunications. A renewed interest is noted in the areas of censorship, administrative skills, audiovisual services, public relations, information skills instruction, and whole language. Articles about publishing are more evident this year. Many bibliographies on a variety of subjects are available.
